Report on Inter College Open House 2025

INTRODUCTION

On 17th April 2025, Government MCA College (GMCA), Maninagar hosted the much-awaited Inter College Open House 2025, a prestigious platform for final-year MCA students (Semester 4)

to present their internship projects.

The event brought together students from various colleges from Ahmedabad pursuing MCA showcasing the collective creativity and technical expertise of young developers. It served as an exhibition of ideas, innovation, and practical application of knowledge, drawing attention from

faculty, students, and visitors alike.

OBJECTIVES OF THE EVENT

The objectives of the Open House event were to provide final-year students with an academic platform to demonstrate their internship projects, to give them an opportunity to interact with experts and alumni evaluators for professional feedback, and to foster cross-institutional collaboration and competition between GMCA, SAL Institute of Technology and Engineering

Research, and R. B. Institute.

Another objective was to motivate juniors by exposing them to real-world project work and to recognize and reward outstanding projects that showcased innovation, technical depth, and

practical relevance.

EVENT DETAILS

The event was structured into **two rounds**:

First Round – Open Exhibition

In the first round, all final-year MCA students presented their projects in front of faculty members and visitors. A total of 27 students are in the first slot, while the second slot included 11 individual

projects and 11 group projects.

All Semester 4 MCA students displayed their projects through live demonstrations, posters, and presentations. The atmosphere was vibrant, with faculty, peers, and visitors interacting directly with participants to understand their project objectives and outcomes.

Projects were evaluated by alumni experts, and three outstanding projects from GMCA were shortlisted for the final round.

Second Round - Final Evaluation

In the second round, selected top projects from each participating college advanced to the final evaluation. In this round, projects were evaluated by a panel of GMCA alumni experts, who are now distinguished industry professionals: **Ms. Monika Malavaniya** (KCG, Ahmedabad), **Mr. Harsh Chauhan** (Ordex Technology, Ahmedabad), and **Mr. Dhruv Chauhan** (Arastu Systems Pvt. Ltd., Ahmedabad).

The alumni shared industry perspectives, asked critical technical questions, and evaluated based on innovation, execution, and future scope.

WINNERS OF THE EVENT

First Place was awarded to **Darshit Natvarlal Rakhasiya** from GMCA for his project on Blockchain-based Secure Navigation for GNSS & Autonomous Lunar Rover Navigation.

Second Place went to **Sutaria Akshilkumar and Talaviya Darshan** from R. B. Institute of Management and Computer Studies for their project Exam Control System.

Third Place (Tie) was shared between two teams: **Rami Jay, Rami Prarthana, and Sadhwani Rishi** from R. B. Institute of Management and Computer Studies for their project AI Hospital, and **Keyur Khatri and Vivek Rathod** from GMCA for their project Employee Monitoring System.

VALEDICTORY

After the completion of the evaluation process, a valedictory session was conducted. Principal **Dr. Chetan Bhatt** delivered a highly motivational speech, encouraging students to pursue excellence with dedication, discipline, and innovation. He emphasized the importance of consistent learning and adapting to emerging technologies in order to remain competitive in the IT industry.
